### **Spotlight on Education**

Presentation by Timberlea Public School Associate Superintendent, Brenda Sautner, introduced Timberlea Public School Vice Principal, Meipsy Shackleford. Several Timberlea students also were in attendance and they presented information to the Board of Trustees regarding their anti-bullying campaign.

# Frank Spragins High School

Associate Superintendent, Brenda Sautner, introduced Principal Roxanne Fudge. Ms. Fudge updated trustees and senior administration on the new focus on arts at Frank Spragins High School. Ms. Fudge provided some handouts relating to the program and Ms. Tiffanie Book provided a brief explanation of the arts program being taught, indicating art can be related into many subjects, including Math, Science, and English.

### FNMI Truth and Reconciliation Event

Associate Superintendent, Brenda Sautner, introduced students who were part of the March 27th Truth and Reconciliation Event in Edmonton. Twenty-five students went from Fort McMurray Public Schools and joined approximately 2,000 students from across Alberta. Elder Hazel "Issapaakii" Derange, Julia McDougall, Caron McBride, Tom MacDonald, Connic Kramer and Quinn Lotsberg were introduced. Eight student representatives spoke about their experience and thanked trustees for the opportunity to participate. Tom MacDonald shared a touching poem written by two students.

#### Paul Martin (MAEI) Initiative

Associate Superintendent, Brenda Sautner, introduced Composite High School teacher Caron McBride who spoke about the Paul Martin Aboriginal Education Initiative. Ms. McBride called upon student Robert Grant to share a powerpoint presentation on entrepreneurship with trustees.

Trustees and senior administration thanked everyone for attending and participating in the Spotlight on Education. Chair Thompson extended a special thank you to Issapaakii for coming to the meeting and asked if she would say a few words. Issapaakii expressed her gratitude for students having the opportunity to hear the story of residential schools and the awareness it created. She was pleased to see the FNMI workers in schools, and encouraged even more opportunities be made available for FNMI students to learn about their own history.

# 21176 Approval of Grade Configuration
