22582	Results and Curriculum Update	Superintendent D. Nicholls shared information from the previous evening's Telephone Town Hall, hosted by the Minister of Education. Participants were informed of the new information available for the draft curriculum and the resources available on the beta website.
	16	Director of Education, Merrie-Rae Mitsopoulos reviewed an example of the website. It was noted that the common misconception regarding the new curriculum is that it is 'brand new'. The Alberta Government has redesigned the information and how it would be presented to students, giving the opportunity to infuse more literacy and numeracy teachings in all subjects.
	M	Superintendent D. Nicholls praised M. Mitsopoulos for her detailed review and dedication

		on the subject and noted that while there are unknown aspects of the curriculum now, change is positive.
22583	Business Arising from Previous Meetings	8.1 Extra Curricular Activities (High School) Review Trustees reviewed the requested comparison of Extra Curricular activities available between the three high schools. It was noted that there is small concern that Fort McMurray Composite High School does not share the same number of activities as the other high schools.
		Superintendent D. Nicholls noted that enrollment at all three schools is different, as well as interest from the students, thus the options between them will be varied.

The next PSBC meeting will be held in November, which he will be attending. A small overview of budget discussions was reviewed and discussed and a change in procedure at PSBA was made to ensure that membership rates were not raised this year.
