	Mental Health in FMPSD	The Removing Barriers to Mental Health continues to increase staff capacity to support students with mental health needs. In partnership with a number of community agencies, a suicide protocol was recently developed. All data pertaining to Mental Health is tracked and shared with Alberta Education. Quarterly reports are submitted to our funder, Alberta Health Services.



		Trustee Adams commented that as a Board Member she is pleased that FMPSD is putting more emphasis on mental health. Superintendent D. Nicholls thanked staff involved in Mental Health for the support that has been provided to staff and students throughout the year. Board Chair J.
