Fort McMurray Composite High School Fall Awards

Fort McMurray Composite High School celebrated the achievements of their students Wednesday night with their Fall Awards celebration.

Every year students who have overall averages in addition to the top marks in each of the core (academic) classes for the school year are recognized in this annual fall event. This year 73 students achieved a yearly average of 75% or higher in addition to all Core class top marks including 13 students who received the Gold Key (sustaining an average of over 85%).
