PRIORITY #1 - SUCCESS FOR ALL STUDENTS

- FMPSD ThoughtExchange went out January 23rd and has seen tremendous participation so far, with 459 responses as of Jan 25th; the ThoughtExchange is planned to end Feb 3rd. The ThoughtExchange is continuously being maintained, and questions are being answered as they arrive in a public forum.
- · The Board of Trustees supports school council parents to attend the Alberta School's Councils Association's Annual Conference by providing funding for two registrations per school or up to one thousand and eighty dollars (\$1080.00) per school.
- A staff wellness check survey with 302 respondents has shown a decrease in workplace-related stress from 5.9 to 5.4 out of 10 from Jan-Dec 2022. Personal stress has also been reduced from 5 in Jan 2022 to 4.34 out of 10 in Dec 2022.
- FMPSD Space Academy, led by the Director of Technology Ali Syed, has seen significant progress after being put on hiatus due to the global pandemic. The academy provides many STEM programming opportunities with the goal of students being able to send an FMPSD satellite into space.
- 5 Parent Engagement sessions have been released on the FMPSD youtube channel and received views ranging from 70-154. Links were sent previously to Network committees but will be resent to principals.
