PRIORITY #1 - SUCCESS FOR ALL STUDENTS

 17 new locally acquired courses have been submitted to Alberta Education to make courses available for FMPSD high school students for September 2023.

PRIORITY #2 - MAINTAIN SAFE AND CARING LEARNING ENVIRONMENT AND SUPPORTS

- Feedback from Stakeholders is currently being considered during the development of the new Education plan. Schools will be presenting to the Board in mid-May.
- The 2024-2025 academic year calendar is under development, and thoughtful consideration has been given to scheduling major breaks to provide ample notice to families and staff.
