### PRIORITY #1 - SUCCESS FOR ALL STUDENTS

- The Board has re-elected Linda Mywaart as the Board of Trustees Chairperson and Jonathan Lambert as the new Board of Trustees Vice-Chairperson. Representatives for each of the board committees were also chosen.
- The Board was ahead of its projected Board Work Plan for 2022/2023, having completed the third and final financial update in the May Board of Trustees Meeting.
- The Policy Committee recommendations were approved by Trustees and this included some revisions to the Board Work Plan.
- The Board approved the 2023/2024 Trustee Meeting Schedule as well as School visits and spotlight on Students dates.



### PRIORITY #2 - MAINTAIN SAFE & CARING LEARNING ENVIRONMENT & SUPPORTS

- Fort McMurray Public School Division is in the process of revising the draft Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Strategic Plan. Some highlights include starting to build capacity among current and incoming staff through various professional learning opportunities to support their continued development in the area of Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Anti-racism. All Fort McMurray Public Schools staff will have required training under this plan. An English Additional Language (EAL) point person at every school site will work with staff to provide support.
