24709	7.0 Action Items 7.3 Preliminary Budget Approval & Transfer of Reserves	Associate Superintendent Kallal presented the Budget Report for the fiscal year ending August 31, 2025.		
		Within that report, Associate Superintendent Kallal advised of the following:		
		"To balance the budget, annual reductions of \$1.75 million per year for three (3) more years will be required. This funding framework has put the Division into deficit budgeting. The lack of severe funding compared to the growth in severe enrollment is unsustainable. The framework utilizes Weighted Moving Average (WMA) enrollment, which results in 378 students being		





		unfunded in this budget. This equates to the total enrollment, whereas the operating deficit is 6.1% of Alberta Education Funding. The WMA is not supporting the students of the FMPSD. Without the elimination of WMA, increased severe and operations and maintenance funding, the Division will deplete its operating reserves and capital reserves to a minimum by August 2027. Reductions to the budget to balance the budget over the next 4 years will impact every department, program and school. Without increased overall funding per pupil, rising costs are increasing the Division's deficit." Budget Report LINK Motion by Trustee Adams THAT the Board of Trustees approves the Budget and Reserve Allocations as amended for the 2024-2025 school year. Questions about the budget and reserves were asked and answered. Chair Mywaart read the question. Carried 5:12 p.m. Trustee Adams expressed that the Advocacy Committee would like to use some of the points and comments made by the Board regarding the budget this evening in their annual advocacy plan at the June Committee of the Whole meeting. This is agreeable to the Board. Chair Mywaart also enquired if it was the wish of the Board to extend an invitation to Minister Nicolaides to the Division. This was agreeable to the Board. TASK: Chair Mywaart will contact Minister Nicolaides to extend an invitation to the Division to discuss various factors within FMPSD.
