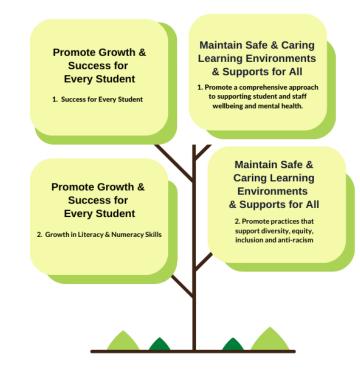

While the funding is welcomed, concerns were raised about: It has limited relevance and timing for local needs. Some assessments are time-consuming and not effective in supporting student progress. The Board will continue their advocacy efforts and focusing on ensuring funding and tools are more relevant and useful for students. Superintendent Nutter advised that the Current-year funding can be rolled over into the next year (e.g., for part-time literacy and numeracy support and that some red tape and reporting requirements have been removed in the updated funding manual.)
