FINANCIAL UPDATES

As presented by Allan Kallal, Associate Superintendent of Business & Finance;

- Currently the enrollment sits at an overall increase of 2% from last year. Final numbers will follow after the September 30th cut-off date.
- While budget projections were higher than what we have so far, there are still 4 schools that have enrollment growth: Fort McMurray Christian school, Walter and Gladys Hill, Westview And Composite High School. We anticipate enrollment of approximately 8186 students.
